# PROSTART TEACHER TRAINING INSTITUTE



For the 11th year, the Florida Restaurant & Lodging Association Educational Foundation (FRLAEF), will conduct the ProStart Teacher Training Institute. This event will once again be held at Johnson & Wales University's (J&W) North Miami Campus. The week long training was developed to provide Florida's ProStart instructors with

the knowledge necessary to teach the ProStart curriculum. Each day's learning is built around topics covered in the ProStart curriculum. At the conclusion of the week, attendees should feel more comfortable teaching the ProStart curriculum to their students.

For the first time ever, the ProStart Teacher Training Institute is broken down into FOUR years of participation. First year attendees will learn about Knife Skills and Dining Room Service as well as

Stocks and Cooking Fundamentals in Food Production. Second year attendees will take an in-depth look at Garde Manger, Advance Cooking Techniques, Soups and Sauces. Third year attendees will continue their ProStart Teacher Training experience by covering Special Event Planning, Advance Kitchen Design and Layout, as well as Cake Decorating and Plated Desserts. The fourth year attendees will focus on baking and pastry along with entrepreneurship. A more detailed schedule of the week's events along with all of the class topics for each level will be included in the information packet. **Space for this event is limited, only participants able to stay for the entire week may attend.**

Due to funding restrictions, only the first 20 applicants for the fourth year training will be guaranteed a spot. Please fax your completed application ASAP to ensure you participate in this exciting week of training.

## EVENING ACTIVITIES

On Sunday evening, FRLAEF and J&W will host a welcome dinner for all attendees. On Monday and Wednesday evening, attendees will enjoy dinner at a local restaurant. The Monday and Wednesday evening activities are mandatory. Participants will have the opportunity to enjoy local sightseeing and shopping via shuttles on Tuesday and Thursday evenings.

## LOCATION

All classes will be held at J&W's North Miami Campus, 1701 NE 127th Street, North

Miami, Florida. J&W's North Miami Campus is conveniently located 20 minutes north of the Miami International Airport and 20 minutes south of the Ft. Lauderdale Airport. Detailed directions will be included in the information packet.

## REQUIREMENTS

Participants must adhere to all J&W professional codes of sanitation and grooming. Each participant must wear chef trousers (no jeans) as well as black, non-skid, hard toe shoes. If you have attended in the past, please bring your

complete professional toolkit.

## PROGRAM COST

The FRLAEF along with its sponsors will cover the cost for all Florida ProStart instructors. This includes instruction, room and meals (excluding dinner on Tuesday and Thursday evening), chef coat and take-home educational materials. **Accommodations are provided in J&W dorms. However, you may stay off campus at your own expense.**

If you are not currently teaching the ProStart curriculum or will not be teaching the

curriculum during the 2007/2008 school year, the cost for you to attend the 11th Annual ProStart Teacher Training Institute is \$800.
